Right at our casual and easy digital Zoom format **"science for lunch"**. **Starting April 16, fortnightly, Fridays 12:45pm, 15 minutes at lunchtime!** You are very welcome to have lunch on the side.

Goal: Learn more about your colleagues' research and collaboration needs in a casual atmosphere without preparation, make contacts, ask questions, inform about your own scientific expertise. We connect you with each other without you having to invest extra time! You are also welcome to introduce yourself and nominate additional interviewees. We have a snowball system with assistance and you can simply use our questionnaire to start the conversation.

Who: There are 2 colleagues initially talking with each other. The first person is invited and nominates the second person, who is asked a few introductory questions and acts as interviewer at the next date. It is a condition that the interview partners are from different disciplines. We would be pleased if you would also actively participate and introduce yourself. Other listeners can join in via the link, participate and/or join the conversation.

How: Ideally, the first 5 minutes are used to interview a person in order to get to know his/her research, collaboration possibilities and needs. Another 10 minutes are to briefly exchange/make contacts with the audience. This can be done verbally or via the chat function.
